# **Game Play**

- Players on the ice:
  - · U11-U18
    - 5vs5 as much as possible
    - If not feasible, then 4vs4 or 3vs3 is ok
    - Players can be added/moved between miniteams (within the cohort) to allow for rosters to be within one player of each other
  - · U9
    - 4vs4 half ice as much as possible
    - Can change to 3vs3 if needed
- Cohort lead coach must approve movement between mini-teams
- NO Affiliates (cannot move players or goalies to a different cohort

# Scorekeeping/Timekeeping

- No official score sheet
- Period length:
  - · U11-U18
    - 60 minute ice time: 13-13-13
    - 75 minute ice time: 12-15-15
  - · U9:
    - Two halves (instead of 3 periods)
    - 90 second shifts with a buzzer
- Maximum of two people in scorekeepers box and both MUST wear masks

# Officiating:

- Coaches or on-ice helpers that are insured by Hockey Canada must be used as referees
  - Parent volunteers or managers cannot be referees
- Any "Major Penalties" for U11-U18 should still result in the player being ejected from the game. Coaches can refer the incident to the coach coordinator or age group coordinators.



#### Goaltenders

- · U9:
  - Goalies will rotate through practices and games as per novice program
- U11:
  - Rotate goalies as per HC hybrid goalie policy
  - If full time goalie vs two hybrid goalies, all 3 can dress and rotate
  - If one mini-team has 2 full-time goalies then rotate at discretion of coaches.
- · U13-18
  - If mini teams have same number of goalies, rotate as per regular season
  - Goalies can float throughout cohort to ensure all goalies have comparable ice time.



# **Dressing Room**

- Coaches must wear a mask in dressing room and on the bench (even if part of the cohort)
- Parents that are not in the cohort cannot be in the dressing room
- No food/snacks in the dressing rooms
- Two coaches in the dressing room at all times (and they should encourage social distancing)



# **Crowfoot Arena Spectator Policy**

- Revised version will be posted tomorrow (Friday)
  - One parent/guardian/family member per player permitted in the stands for GAMES
    - 10 spectators per stand and up to 27 in the catwalk viewing area. Must be on an X.
    - No standing against glass or in lobby
  - Spectators cannot enter until ice time has begun and must exit immediately after game



# **Crowfoot Arena Spectator Policy**

- Revised version sill be posted tomorrow (Friday)
  - Volunteer is required to spray down handrail upstairs and the seating and touch areas in the stands
  - Volunteer is required to let spectators in once players take to the ice and ensure they leave immediately after the game
  - Keep a list of attendance (for your mini-team) for 20 days
  - Managers are NOT required to screen spectators for COVID
    - All people should be self screening and following public health protocols



# **Crowfoot Arena Spectator Policy**

- What if someone breaks the rules?
  - Example: two parents (that are not coaches/manager) attend
  - "Anyone found not abiding by these rules may cause a delay in the game until the issue is resolved"
  - Manager is to ask the person to leave. If they don't leave, manager to go to head coach on the bench.
    - Head coach will pause the game
    - Game will not be restarted until person leaves or issue is resolved

- Mini Team Limitations:
  - At this time there will be:
    - No team purchase of apparel
      - Tuxedo sports is available for individuals to purchase crowfoot items
    - No tournaments
    - No bank accounts
      - No fundraising
      - No cash calls



- Deposit Cheques dated Mar 1, 2021:
  - Jersey Deposit (\$200 to Crowfoot Hockey)
  - Volunteer Deposit (\$200 to Crowfoot Hockey)
- Collect Health Forms
  - Sealed envelopes
  - Place in first aid kit
- SUGGEST: clearly state to parents (via teamsnap email) 2-3 different times that you will be available to collect these



- Team Snap:
  - Ice Schedule is automatically uploaded
  - Remind families to double check contact info
  - Remind families/players they must indicate availability in teamsnap prior to icetime



- Recruit Volunteers:
  - Jersey Parents
  - 2-3 parents that will take turns to spray down the stands and touch areas and hand rails
  - 3-4 parents that will take turns timekeeping
  - 2-3 parents that will take turns letting spectators into the arena and ensuring prompt exiting
- Maintain a list of all spectators at each game for at least
  20 days
- Maintain a list of volunteer hours for each family
  - (hours will transfer over to regular season)
